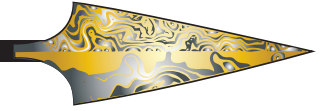


# BOEGER



## 2016 Barbera

### Blend

100% Barbera

### Wine Chemistry

Alcohol 14.8%  
RS 0.08%  
pH 3.57

### Production

Fruit hand harvested from late August to early October, 2016.  
Aged one year in primarily neutral French and American barrels,  
with some newer American barrels used.  
Bottled December 21, 2017.  
7,740 cases produced.

### Winemaker's Notes

**Aroma** – Brimming with ripe, red fruits- cherry and red currant-  
with slight notes of caramel and smoke.  
**Palate** – Plush and full throughout with very soft tannins and  
lingering acidity on the finish.

A variety of clones grown on vineyards between 2,000 and 3,000 ft.  
are used to make up our Barbera, creating a perfect representation  
of El Dorado county Barbera. Mouth-wateringly aromatic, this wine  
jumps out of the glass with luscious red fruit aromas. Soft and full on  
the palate, this wine is a pleasure to drink on its own, but its inherent  
acidity also makes it a perfect accompaniment to most dishes.

Aging Potential – Drink now through 2022.
