Winemaker's Notes

Aroma – Ripe dark fruit, black currant, licorice, briar

Palate – Medium full body, considerable tannins provide full, pronounced structure.

The large majority of the Cabernet Sauvignon grapes for this wine are sourced from our Peek Vineyard. At 3,000 feet elevation, this vineyard provides excellent growing conditions for Cabernet, where brisk night temperatures help retain Cabernet's notable acidity and typical varietal aromas. The remainder of the Cabernet grapes comes from our Estate Vineyard, and contributes slightly softer tannins and more pronounced fruit aromas. The small amount of Petit Verdot was blended to round out the wine's tannin structure, palate and age-worthiness.
