Winemaker's Notes:

Aroma – Concentrated dark fruit, black peppercorn, overtones of tarragon and other herbs.

Palate – bright and lively with firm, tight tannins.

Refosco and Aglianico provide woody, herbal aromas to balance the inherent fruitiness of Carignane and Charbono.
