Production

Fruit hand harvested late September and early October, 2015. Aged 14 months in neutral American oak barrels. Bottled January 26, 2017. 530 cases produced.

Winemaker's Notes

Aroma – Dried blueberries, black peppercorn, tobacco leaf and fig. Palate – Full and rich with mouthfilling, rich structure. Lingering tannins on the finish.

For many years, Petite Sirah was used at Boeger Winery primarily as a blending component in our various Zinfandels. Our first 100% varietal bottling was done in 1997, and we've followed suit ever since. Naturally inky in color with concentrated dark fruit aromas and rich, chewy tannins, Petite Sirah is a naturally big, structured wine. Approximately 40% of the grapes used in this blend come from the Walker Vineyard in southern El Dorado county, and impart the tobacco leaf aromas typical of that vineyard. The remaining 60% is Estate fruit.

Aging Potential – Drink now through 2022.
